1 About Module Manager

1.1 What is Module Manager?

Module Manager is a part of the GoPro Professional product line. It is a tool for administrators for customising and upgrading components in GoPro Case Professional.

Module Manager provides the following functionality:

- Displays installed modules in GoPro Case databases.
- Provides one-click access for installing new versions of modules
- Provides the option to un-install modules.

2 Things you need to know

2.1 System Requirements

Module Manager only works with GoPro Case Professional version 4.0.0 or higher. For GoPro Case requirements see below.

2.1.1 Server

Server requirements according to the GoPro Case Professional Server requirements.

2.1.2 Client

Notes client requirements according to the GoPro Case Professional Client requirements.

3 Installation

Due to changes in Lotus Notes from version 6.02 to 6.03 there are two different set-up files for Module Manager:

For Lotus Notes 6.02 or lower, use `ModuleManager_for_Notes_6.0.2_and_below.exe`.

For Lotus Notes 6.03 or higher, use `ModuleManager_for_Notes_6.0.3_and_above.exe`.

3.1 How to install Module Manager

- Download the appropriate installer.
- Double-click on the installer icon to start the installer program.
- Follow the on-screen instructions for installation.

3.1.1 Lotus Notes Initialization error on startup

Module Manager requires access to the Notes DLL's and a Notes.ini file. Users with multiple Notes clients installed and/or Domino servers, might experience errors when running Module Manager. This might be due to the fact that Module Manager is using an incorrect directory to run the Notes DLL's, and therefore cannot run. To fix this problem it is usually enough to install a notes client to your main Notes client directory, and the Notes setup program will update the registry accordingly, and Module Manager should work correctly.

Windows registry is also pointing to the DLL required for "Lotus Domino Objects" COM interface (nlsxbe.dll). If the registry points to the wrong or invalid file, Module Manager will not work. The probable solution to this would be to uninstall the Notes

client, and do a clean install, and Notes should update the registry with the correct value. (You can also search for nlsxbe.dll in the registry to modify the path manually)

3.1.2 Password is always prompted when starting Send2GoPro

Password is required when Module Manager is initiated, without a Notes client running. However, when the Notes client is running, users can skip entering the password, by setting the option "Don't prompt for a password from other Notes based programs", in the "File-Tools-UserID" dialog in the Notes client.

3.1.3 No access to database

If users are using multiple ID files, Module Manager, uses the ID file that is active in the Notes client each time. The wrong ID file can cause problems with accessing GoPro databases.
