# 1 About GoPro Case Scanning Module

## 1.1 What is the Scanning module?

The GoPro Case Scanning module is a part of the GoPro Professional product line. The Scanning module is an add-on to GoPro Case which provides the following functionality:

- Enables scanning directly from within GoPro Case, using ScanSoft Paperport or Spicer.
- Enables import of attachments.
- Provides the possibility to edit attachments that have been imported.

## 3 Migration

### 3.1 Migrating from version 4.x.x to 4.2.x

#### 3.1.1 New Trash view

When an incoming document containing attachments stored in the GDM store is marked for deletion, the update agent running each night synchronizes the marked for deletion flag over to the GDM store document. This results in the GDM store document being moved to the new Trash view in the GDM store database.

To create the new Trash view you need to update the design of the GDM store database:

- Go to the module settings for the Scanning Module from within the GoPro Constants document
- Perform the action 'Create GDM store database'.

Note! This action will only update the design of the existing GDM store database.

## 4 What's new?

### 4.1 Version 4.2.0 build 20060324

#### **E-Mailing attachments from incoming documents**

When e-mailing attachments from incoming documents using the action 'Attachment... — send as email' it is now possible to deselect attachments that are not be sent.

#### **Email from Incoming documents with no attachments.**

When trying to send email from an incoming document that had no attachments, no dialog appeared and no email was sent. This has now been fixed. When the action 'Attachment... — Send as email' is used with an incoming document that has no attachments, the user is prompted to send the email anyway.

#### **Hiding action when the body field is locked**

The action 'Action — Attach file' is now hidden when the body field is locked. If the body field is locked it should not be possible to add an attachment to the document or the related gdm store document.

Fixed a translation in a dialog prompting when opening incoming documents with gdm store objects.

#### **Copies of Incoming documents including GDM Store objects**

Support has been added to the incoming documents to keep track of copied documents. When an incoming document is copied and the original is then deleted, the gdm store objects are not marked for deletion in the gdm store database until all copies of the incoming documents have been deleted.

Fixed a problem where the scanning button disappeared when a sender had been selected for the incoming document.

## 4.2 Version 4.2.0 build 20051125

### New trash view in the GDM store database

When an incoming document containing attachments stored in the GDM store is marked for deletion, the update agent running each night synchronizes the marked for deletion flag over to the GDM store document which then will be moved to the new Trash view in the GDM store database. To update the design of the GDM store database, go to the module settings for the Scanning Module from within the GoPro Constants document and use the action 'Create GDM store database'. This action will only update the design of the existing GDM store database.

### Send as email dialog improved

The user interface of the send as email dialog has been improved since some users did not click on the standard "To:" text in order to select the recipients (the same behaviour as within Notes email documents).

### Scanning with Paperport

A new option has been added to the module settings for the Scanning Module. It is now possible to select 'Paperport' as a scanning method instead of just the 'Paperport scandirect' option. This helps users to scan multiple documents without being prompted to continue after every page like it is with the scandirect option. After scanning multiple documents with the Paperport client, simply drag the scanned object to the Send2GoPro link to add it to the incoming document requesting the scan.

### "[Scanner]" role for changing attachment.

The restriction to have the "[Scanner]" role in order to change attachment with associated application has been removed. Now, this action is available to all users.

## **Default values for exclude list.**

When configuring the module settings for the Scanning Module, the default values for the exclude list are now set to be 'DOC, XLS, PPT'.

## **Access to GDM documents within older GDM databases**

When an attachment registered to be stored in GDM is not found using the server and database location from the module settings configuration, the original location saved within the Incoming document itself will be used as an alternative search. This helps users to launch objects that are stored in another/older location than currently configured.

## **Critical fix: Deletion of archived Incoming documents**

When an incoming document, containing an attachment in the GDM store was archived the incoming document as such was moved to the trash bin of GoPro. When running the administrative action within the trash bin to remove documents from the trash bin, the linked attachments in GDM were also removed. This has been addressed and the attachment will not be deleted.

## **Fix: Performance improvement**

The runtime of the update agent running within the GDM database has been decreased and its performance improved.

## **Fix: Sent information in email header**

When an email is sent with the 'Send as email' action from the incoming document, the email document saved as response to the incoming document now shows the sent information correctly. (Date sent and the sender)

## **Fix: Email forward using GDM attachments**

When using the standard GoPro email forward action from within an Incoming document, all objects/attachments stored in a GDM store as well as those attachments stored within the Incoming document itself are copied into the forwarding email document. In earlier versions, only the attachments currently in the incoming document were forwarded.

### **Fix: Attachment names in incoming documents.**

When adding a new attachment to an incoming document already containing an attachment, the attachment names displayed in the document sometimes did not show the name of the new attachment immediately. This has been fixed.

#### **Fix: Sending attachments of an incoming document as email**

The action "Attachment-Send as email" which sends all related attachments of an incoming document as email was not working properly, resulting in a "Type mismatch" error being displayed under certain circumstances. This has been fixed.

### **4.4 Version 4.1.2 build 20050318**

#### **Fix: MS Office documents containing spaces within the filename not opening**

When trying to open MS Office attachments stored within a GDM document they did not open correctly if their filename contained one or more spaces. This has been fixed.

#### **Fix: "Attachment-send as email" action now sends all attachments**

When using the filter mechanism of the Scanning Module, allowing some file types to remain within the incoming documents for searching purposes, a side effect was that the action "Attachment-Send as email" only sent the attachments that were stored within the GDM database, not the attachments stored within the incoming document. This has been fixed so that all attachments, both from the incoming document as well as the underlying GDM document are now sent.

#### **Fix: Local replicas not finding the correct GDM Store database.**

When using a local replica of GoPro and adding an attachment in an incoming document, the Scanning Module will now search for the GDM database configured in the constants document of the user.

## 4.5 Version 4.1.2 build 20050128

### Multiple attachments - Selecting which attachment to open

When an incoming document contains multiple attachments a GDM document containing all the attachments was previously opened when clicking on the GDM Object icon. This behaviour has been changed in order to maintain the user's context so that instead of opening the GDM document a small menu is displayed with the list of attachments allowing the user to select which attachment to launch.

### Focus set to the launched object

Previously when launching attachments from the incoming document the application showing the object did not override the focus of the Notes client. Since the next logical user step after launching an attachment is to view it this behaviour has been changed so that the application showing the object will now get the focus.

### Delayed notification prompt

In a usage scenario when an incoming document is created, recipients of a notification are selected and then the scanning button is pressed (instead of adding the recipients of a notification after the scanning process), the user will now be prompted to send the notifications when finally leaving the document after the scanning process (instead of being asked to send the notifications when starting the scanning process).

### Send attachment as email

When clicking on the GDM icon within an incoming document a menu pops up allowing a number of actions to be taken. Such as opening a chosen attachment , opening the GDM document itself (the document actually containing the attachment within the GDM database) as well as send the attachments as email, resulting in the same behaviour as clicking on the "Attachments/Send as email" action in the menubar.

## **Customization: Increased support to Scanning Module by GoPro APIs**

The option of calling a GoPro Document Management routine when saving Incoming documents containing attachments has been added to the GoPro API calls. If the GoPro Case Scanning Module is installed (as of version 4.1.2 of the Scanning Module as well as version 4.1.2 of the kernel), all configured attachments will be copied to the GDM database, storing the attachments outside of GoPro.

## **Attachments inserted into the incoming document**

By using the appropriate actions of the incoming document, attachments can be imported into the document and automatically be transferred to the storage database.

## **Include/exclude list**

In order to make PDFs, Word documents, Excel documents, text files etc. searchable directly from within GoPro Case an option has been added to include/exclude file extensions from the process. If the include option is used, only the registered file extensions will be transferred into the storage database whereas if the exclude option is used all but those registered will be transferred (i.e. if everything except for .doc files should be transferred into the storage database then the exclude option should be selected and the .doc extension registered).

## **Scanner role needed for those using the scanning options**

When the Scanner is activated some new options become available in the incoming document.

## **Sending attachments from GoPro Case by email**

A new option has been added to the incoming document - Send as email. This option allows the user to write and send an email including the attachment without creating a second copy of the attachment inside GoPro Case.
