# 1 About GoPro Case Versioning Module

## 1.1 What is the Versioning module?

The GoPro Case Versioning module is a part of the GoPro Document Management Professional product line. The Versioning module is an add-on to GoPro Case which provides the following functionality:

- Versioning can be enabled for documents resulting in the option to store a number of versions of the document.
- For documents with versioning enabled, previous versions of the document can be previewed and/or retrieved.
- The R6 locking features can be utilized, allowing document locking as well as an overview of locked documents in the GoPro Case database. This feature will only be available when running in a Domino R6 environment.

## **2 Things You Need To Know**

### **2.1 System Requirements**

Installing the Versioning Module using the GoPro Case Module Manager requires:

#### **2.1.1 GoPro Case Professional version 4.0.2 or above**

Support for the Versioning module was introduced in version 4.0.2 of GoPro Case Professional. The Versioning module can not be used from within an older version of GoPro Case.

#### **2.1.2 Server**

Server requirements according to the GoPro Case 4 Server requirements.

Please note, however, that the locking features of the Versioning module will only be available when running on a Domino R6 environment.

#### **2.1.3 Client**

Notes client requirements according to the GoPro Case 4 Client requirements.

Please note, however, that the locking features of the Versioning module will only be available when running on a Domino R6 environment.

## 3 What's New?

### 3.1 Version 4.2.0 build 20051125

#### **Automatic versioning is activated when document is created**

When using the automatic versioning option the automatic versioning is now activated when the document is created instead of only being activated when the document was saved.

#### **Customisation: Added customization options to hide the version control subform**

The version control subform can now be hidden by setting a field called "versionControl-Hide" with the value "1".

#### **Fix: Updated about dialog**

Updated the about dialog to same look and feel as other modules.

#### **Fix: ACL issues**

When a user did not have access to the versioning database the version number of the document was incorrectly incremented although no new version was saved. This has been fixed.

#### **Fix: No prompt for version cleanup**

The expected prompt for version cleanup did not appear when the option "Prompt for version on each save" was active. This has been fixed.

## **Fix: Versioning and Scanning**

When an incoming document containing a reference to an attachment within GDM was placed into versioning the result was that the incoming document itself participated in the versioning process but not the external attachment. This has now been fixed so what happens now is that when a document is put into version control all the external attachments are retrieved and stored within the document resulting in a normal version control for both the document as well as its attachments.

## **Fix: Replication conflicts and circular reference**

When a replication save conflict happened on a version controlled document, sometimes it created a circular reference resulting in the document vanishing from the view. This was a result of a bug in Notes but a workaround has now solved the problem.

## **3.2 Version 4.1.0 build 20040616**

### **Document version number visible in standard GoPro Case views**

The version number of a document using the versioning feature is now visible in standard GoPro Case views.

### **Locked document can't be in version control**

Only documents having an active status can be put into version control since locked or completed documents should not be tampered with. If the user wants a completed document to put into version control the status of the document has first to be changed into an active status.

### **Extracting attachments from older versions of a document**

It is now possible to extract and/or view attachments stored in an older version of a document.

### **Printing Letter/Fax printed an extra table**

This has been fixed, now no versioning information are printed in Letter/Fax.

## **Fixed a bug in printing of Fax/Letter**

Fixed a bug when printing Fax/Letter the version field was displayed in a box. Now the versioning will not be printed in Fax/Letter.

## **Ability to write comments when saving a version**

When creating a new version of a document the user can now add some comments stating what has been changed. These comments can be viewed when retrieving/previewing older versions of the document.

## **Preview older versions button is now always available**

Before the preview button was only available if the document was in version control and became hidden when a document left the version control process. The result was that older versions of a document were only available while the document resided in version control. This has been changed so that as soon as document has been put in version control the button will always be available.
